

## **[Important Notice for Tuition Payment and Scholarship]**

Please read carefully below information regarding Reinforced/Changed Rules and Regulations for Tuition Payment as well as Eligibility for Scholarship which was decided by the GSIS Academic Affairs committee, which have been taken effect since 2012 spring semester.

### **[Reinforced/Changed Rules and Regulations for Scholarship]**

1. All the scholarship will be given to the students only who complete the tuition payment of the previous semester according to GSIS guideline.

In other words, students who couldn't complete the tuition payment according to GSIS guideline would be exempted from the 2015 spring semesters' Scholarship beneficiary list regardless of his/her GPA.

Please refer the Article for the scholarship eligibility and the tuition payment periods below.

### **[Reinforced Rules for Tuition Payment]**

1. Students who do not pay the tuition by Final tuition payment period will be automatically removed from a school register. Students cannot pay their tuition after the Final tuition payment at any reasons, since students who cannot make the payment until the last payment period will be expelled from the university.

We hope you understand all above reinforced/changed rules and regulations for scholarship and be cooperative so that all the scholarship system go through smoothly and fair!
