1. Online(Non-face-to-face)

1) Recorded Video Lecture: Only full recorded video lecture without real-time or face-to-face classes

2) Live Lecture: Operates as a real-time live lecture

3) Recorded Video Lecture + Live Lecture: Operates by the combination of the recorded video lecture and real-time live lecture

2. Partial face-to-face class: Above online 1)~3) options with partial face-to-face class. Please check 'Classes and Tests types for the GSIS 2021-2 semester' file shared separately and each class's syllabus for the date&time information of face-to-face classes.

3. Offline(Face-to-face): General face-to-face class. Recorded video lectures will be offered as well.
