Does the university charge tuition fees?	In Germany, tuition fees ("Studiengebühren") are mostly abolished. However, a semester fee ("Semesterbeitrag") has to be paid by students. This is approximately 400.00 € per semester. Exchange students are exempt from the included administrative fee and therefore pay a reduced amount (around 325.00 €).
